Due to a widening of the pupil, dilating drops may blur your vision for about 4-6 hours, and in some cases longer. Because dilation will vary for everyone it is not possible for us to know how much your vision will be affected. Driving may be difficult after an examination and we recommend that you have someone to drive you. If you still choose to drive while your eyes are dilated, Mark A.
